European legislation

Regulation (EU) № 910/2014 on electronic identification and trust services for electronic transactions in the internal market and repealing Directive 1999/93, adopted by the European parliament and the Council

Main purposes of Regulation 910/2014

- Eliminating existing differences between national legislations and the lack of interoperability of electronic signatures;
- Ensuring security of transactions between citizens, businesses and admin. authorities;
- Mutual acceptance and recognition of electronic identification schemes, notified to the Commission.




